

Parent's supporting their child's return to school presentation

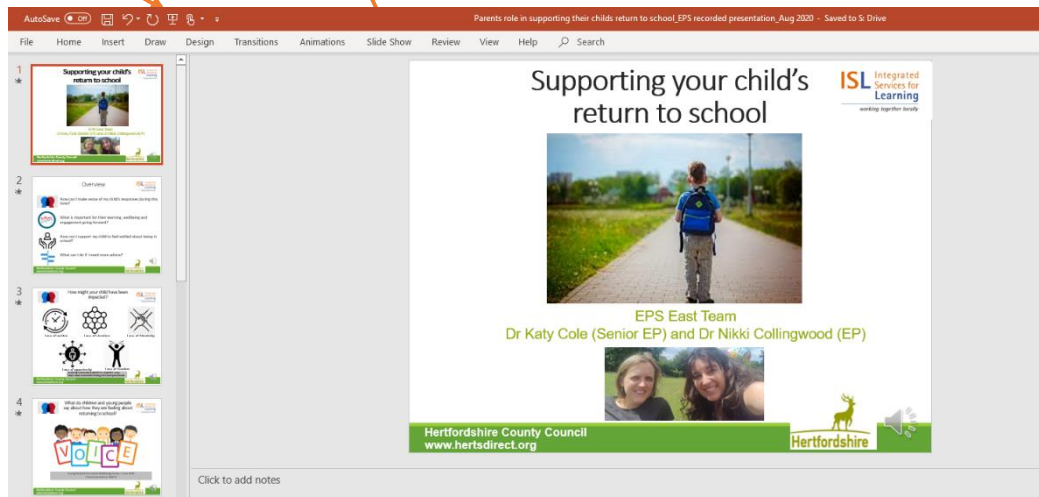
Step 1: Playing the slideshow:

a) Slideshow mode


To go into slideshow mode, you can either press the slide show tab or press the symbol



The presentation should just start running when you click on the slide show, however you may not find it easy to pause in this mode.



b) Playing the recording in normal onscreen slide mode

In normal slide mode, each slide has a speaker sign  .

You may need to click on the speaker to play the audio dependent on your version of powerpoint.

To change the volume, click on the speaker symbol and adjust the sound. If you find that the recording is on mute, make sure to check the volume level.



c) Pausing the recording

To pause the video, while in **normal** mode (not Slide Show mode) you can press the SPACE bar or the pause/play button.
