ACADEMIC YEAR 2025-2026

On Thursday (10th July) it is Transition Day. On this day all children will move up to their new class for September and spend the morning with their new teacher, with their new classmates and in their new classroom. This is to give everyone an opportunity to get to know each other and to support children with the changes coming in September.

We have thought very carefully about the children in our school and how we can best support them academically but also with their social and emotional needs too. After a lot of thought and discussions, we have decided that our classroom set ups will be slightly different in the new school year.

EYFS will be made up of Nursery (Mulberry) and two Reception classes (Ash & Elm).

KS1 will have one Year 1 class (Willow) and two Year 1/2 classes. (Beech and Chestnut)

LSK2 will have one Year 3 class (Oak) and two Year 3/4 classes (Rowan & Laurel).

UKS2 will have one Year 5 class (Hazel) and two Year 5/6 classes (Sycamore and Cedar)

You will notice we have decided to go back to our tree names for our classrooms. We have enjoyed being countries this year but missed our tree names!

Your child will bring a slip home on Thursday which will tell you what class they are in and who their teacher will be.

We do have some new members of staff who will be joining us in September. We are delighted to welcome Mrs Bruce to our teaching team and she will be job sharing with Mrs Stalley, our Deputy Headteacher. We are very pleased to welcome Miss Bignold, Mrs Burgess-Roberts and Mrs Watson to our support team.

After school on Thursday 10th, classrooms will be open so you can visit your child's new classroom and meet their teacher for next year. This will be an informal event where everyone can start to get to know each other.
