This leads to arguments and behaviour issues in school. Also please could children just have one small keyring on their school bag as this also causes arguments during the school day.

Thank you to all the parents who ensure their child is in the correct uniform each day. The children look very smart and this helps the children with their attitude to their learning.

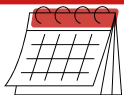
