Dear Parents and Carers,

This week our Reception classes and Cherry Class went on their school trip to Lea Valley Farm. They had a great day and were excited to tell us all about it when they returned. Their behaviour was excellent and I am very proud of them all. Thank you to our EYFS team and parent volunteers who attended the trip, I really appreciate your support.

As we come to the end of the year, we are evaluating the wrap around care provided at Churchfield. I have listened to all feedback that I have received and I want to ensure our wrap around care is of the highest standard. We have decided to go with a new provider called Premier Education. They will provide Breakfast Club and After School Club. There is a parent questionnaire that Premier Education have sent for parents to complete so they can fully understand the needs of the families at Churchfield (the link is in the email that this newsletter came from). If you use our wrap around care, please complete this. The timings will stay the same (Breakfast Club will begin at 7.30 and After School Club will run until 5.30). There is a slight annual increase to the cost. Breakfast Club will be £5.75 and After School Club will be £10.75.

The last day of After School Club this year will be on Monday 20th July. Breakfast Club will run as normal on Tuesday 21st.

Our End of Year class parties will be on Friday 17th July in the afternoon. This will be an opportunity for the children to celebrate the end of the school year with their class. Children can wear non uniform on this day. Please no football kits, crop tops or short shorts. Thank you.

Next week Sports Day is going ahead as planned. We will keep an eye on the weather and will update you if anything changes. I want to go ahead with this event as this is the last available date we have, I do not want to cancel as it is a great day for the children and parents. We will make arrangements to ensure the children are well looked after.
